This letter means that a marriage was found in the registry of the RGD based on a match between the applicant's birth particulars and a marriage record in the database.

e.g. If John Doe applied for a No-Impediment with the particulars:

Name: John Doe

Date of Birth: 4th July 1980

Father's Name: Gary Brown

Parish of residence: St. Catherine

and a marriage record was found bearing the same particulars then a No-Impediment letter is issued.

If you receive a No-Impediment letter and you believe that it is in error you should return the letter to the RGD who will do the necessary investigations.
